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Child Find Notice- **Proportionate Share Meeting**

The Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) requires that the school system provide information to private school administrators regarding the provision of equitable special education services to parentally-placed private school students with disabilities within the Worth County School District boundaries. Children who are homeschooled are also considered parentally-placed private school students. Private schools referenced include home schools. Parentally-placed students with disabilities in private schools are not entitled to a Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE), but the district will provide services based on a proportionate share of federal funds.

To plan accordingly for the 2021-2022 school year, Worth County Schools would like to meet with representatives of private schools or home schools located in Worth County.
