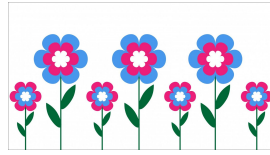

The Georgia Milestones Assessment will be administered this month:

The Georgia Milestones Assessment System is a comprehensive assessment system spanning grades 3 through high school. Georgia Milestones measures how well students have learned the knowledge and skills outlined in the state adopted content standards in English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies. Students in grades 3 through 8 will take the End-of-Grade (EOG) measures in each content area, while high school students will take the appropriate End-of-Course (EOC) measure for the ten identified courses.

In compliance with the requirements of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act the Worth County Schools would like to inform you that you may request information about the professional qualifications of your student's teacher(s). The following information may be requested: 1) Whether the teacher has met the Georgia Professional Standards Commission's requirements for certification for the grade level and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction; 2) Whether the teacher is teaching under an emergency or other provisional status through which Georgia qualifications or certification criteria have been waived; 3) The college major and any graduate certification or degree held by the teacher; 4) Whether the student is provided services by paraprofessionals, and if so, their qualifications. If you wish to request information concerning your child's teacher or paraprofessional qualification, please contact the principal at your child's school.
